# FY2015 and FY2016 Strategies

- Reduce approval and firm order allocations
- Use Endowments
- Cancellations
  - Databases
  - eBook Collections
  - Journals



# FY2017 and FY2018 Strategies

- Annualize subscriptions
  - Cost share across campus
  - Negotiate with vendors to cap costs (CPI-W rate)
  - Reallocate funds from one-time purchases to subscriptions
  - Increase Demand Driven Acquisitions
    - Allocate more money to PDA
    - Implement print DDA
