**Ken Ebo** is currently an instructor at U.S. Navy School of Music located on Little Creek Joint Expeditionary Base in Virginia Beach, Virginia. He received his undergraduate degree in music from Indiana University where he was a student of M. Dee Stewart, David Baker, and Dominic Spera. After several years teaching and performing on the road Ken completed his master's at the University of South Carolina where he studied with Dr. Brad Edwards and Bill Zehfuss. He has 25 years of professional performing and education experience, both civilian and military. Ken is a former recipient of the Musician of the Year Award for the US Marine Corps and has played lead trombone for the USMC All-Star Jazz Ensemble since 2009. An active clinician and performer, he has also organized and directed since 2003 a series of benefit concerts for Toys for Tots in Baltimore as well as Virginia Beach. Ken regularly lays off the horn Saturday mornings to watch Looney Tunes with his wife and two children.
